VALE GAYLE GERRARD



Gayle was passionate about youth and took on the role of organising the Learn-To-Swim programme for many years, even after she resigned from Rotary, she still assisted in this area.

Gayle was recognised with a Paul Harris Fellowship Award in December 2022, for her work in the community, with Rotary and through her caring role with Lethborg Funerals.

Gayle resigned from the Club in 2015.


