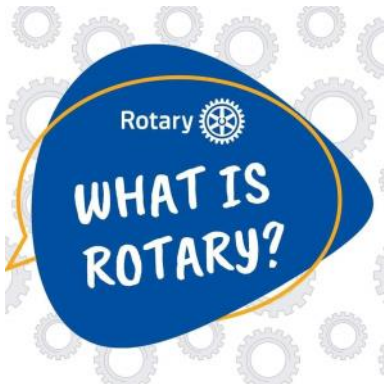
## LEARN-TO-SWIM
